

About the technical requirements:

I need one day to set up (the day of the performance) and about 2 hours to get out.

Death is Certain is approx. 35 min long.

This performance is for max. 40 spectators that are standing, if more than 40 people would like to see the show, I can do it more than once an evening. I need about an hour in between the shows, if I have someone there who helps me clean and set up again.

About the space + light: the best is a smaller room that reminds of a class room or a room in a hospital. With neon lights already in it.

There are a few things I need that I would be very grateful if you could arrange them for me before I come:

1. 500g of fresh cherries (with the green stalk) per performance.
In October they are hard to find, but maybe if you arrange it so far in advance it might be possible. If it turns out to be impossible, there is an emergency solution.

2. a bottle of Helium to blow up a balloon in the show

3. 2 big tables (1m x 1,50m x 80cm or bigger)

4. normal extension cable + adapter for German plug

5. several objects, that you might have around anyways or that I'm not allowed to take in an airplane or that are too heavy:

brick or a heavy weight

bucket

carafe for water

Hammer

Drill

White vinegar

Bigger sized sugar cubes

1Kg of plaster

Cherry jam (if we use e.g. strawberries as an alternative then strawberry jam)

shiny golden spray paint

Zippo lighter fluid (petrol for zippo lighters)

(not allowed to take it in the airplane)

6. I'm making some small fires in the show:

I put about 20 matches on a plate and light them

I pour a little bit of rum on a plate and light it

I light a cigarette

There is a bucket of water under the table and I have 2 cups of water on the table, next to the fire.

These little fires are very important within the performance.

7. Safety precautions:

a fire extinguishers

one bucket of water under the table

that the escape routes are being respected

8. A possibility to wash the aprons that I'm wearing in the performance.
